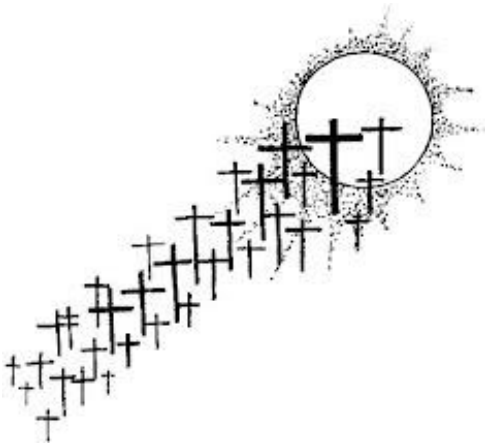

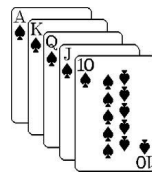

Church Council Minutes, October 20, 2015

Rick called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Pastor Kloos opened in prayer.

**Monthly Reports:**

**Secretary's Report:** Submitted by Kelly Walz. Motion to accept by Tom, seconded by Ellen

**Current Expense Fund:** Motion to accept by Tom, seconded by Dale

**Check Register Reports:** Checks # 28145 thru # 28173. Motion to accept by Tom, 2nd by Dale

**Building/Memorial Funds/Other Special Funds:** Motion to accept by Tom, seconded by Dale.

**Ministry of Finance:** It was discussed that Thrivent Choice Dollar letters would need to be submitted to Linda in the office, along with the name of the fund the person is delegating it too.

**Ministry of Property:** Tom noted that he was looking for gravel to fill around the drain in the parking lot.

**Ministry of Worship:** Robbie submitted her report:

6 new Acolyte Robes have arrived and the acolytes have been fit. Waist cords have been ordered.

Songs for the Hand Bells has been ordered.

It was discussed to keep Val on as the Choir accompanist, since Sheldon will start as the full time organist in January, 2016.

The microphones were checked to make sure when taping the choir services, that they could be heard in their new location in the front pews, instead of behind the cross.

Pastor Steve Lein will be here on November 15, 2015 at the 10:30 a.m. service to install Pastor Ed. He will answer questions between services and there will be a luncheon following the installation.

We will be providing cookies for the Thanksgiving Community Service on Tuesday, Nov. 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m.

**Social Ministry & Outreach:** No Report Submitted

**Ministry of Congregational Life:** Linda noted that the Community Picnic served 167 people. There were enough donations to cover costs for the picnic. The additional funds collected were given to the food pantry.

**Ministry of Education:** Dale handed out a copy of the Job Description for the Sunday School Superintendent/Coordinator. Dale made a motion to approve this description and it was seconded by Robbie. It will be kept in the church office files with the rest of the job descriptions.

**Ministry of Communication:** No Report Submitted. It was noted that Darla needs the password to make changes on the church website. Maria will work with her.

**Ministry of Youth & Family:** Ellen discussed the plan for "Trunk or Treat" for Sunday Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> after the 10:30 a.m. service for Pre-K thru 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The party will follow from 11:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. with games and lunch. Ellen also noted that Robbie is starting to work on the Christmas Program.

**Pastoral Report:**

Pastor Ed noted that the communion at every service has been well received.

Pastor Ed asked the Council for permission to give the electric Yamaha Piano to Kaylee Oczepek. Kaylee had been doing music at the Sunday 5 p.m. service. The piano is in need of repairs and is currently not being used. The council unanimously approved giving the piano to Kaylee.

Pastor Ed noted that the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday service of each month will be a "Healing Service" or "Prayer Service". This could be for a physical, emotional or spiritual healing for you or a loved one.

### **Office Reports – Linda:**

Two checks were received from National Financial Services, LLC \$28,899.62 and \$18,786.67. These checks are from the Berthal Fisher accounts that were closed. Maria will deposit these checks. It was noted that there is one remaining Berthal Fisher account that will not mature until the end of the year. It is earning 7% interest and will remain there until the end of the year.

A resignation letter was received from Sue Trinklein to withdraw her church membership and ministry at CLC. Motion was made by Tom and seconded by Maria and unanimously voted by the council members to accept her resignation letter and file it in the office.

### **Unfinished Business:**

Electrical / Lighting – Repaired the old lighting board for use as a backup. It was noted that the banner light needs to be turned back into the correct position.

Baptismal Font – will be removing and we will need to have the hole in the floor refilled.

Pastor's Moving Expenses – Just received the bill in the amount of \$7,767.17. Council had approved \$4,900 with the rest to come from donations. Pastor paid to move his personal office belongings. The council approved that additional donations that were collected for moving expenses be given to Pastor or reimburse him for part of his office moving expenses.

Bathroom Drains – It was noted that these drains need to be flushed out. This will be referred to Kevin to investigate the problems.

Hiring Additional Office Help – It was agreed upon to post the help needed in the church newsletter for additional office help for Monday's and to cover the office for vacations or days off for Linda. This position would include working with the Powerpoint slides, the newsletter and answering the phone.

### **New Business:**

Nominating Committee – Tabled at this time.

Air Conditioning – informational – 2 quotes were received – 1 from Freeland and 1 from New-

ton's in Vassar. This is for 2 to 5 separate units that can be installed in the Sanctuary that are quiet and would have heat pumps. Quotes were roughly \$5,000 for each unit. Further investigation is needed and a committee will be formed to determine any future action.

Clock for the Church Sanctuary – a clock will be added to the back of the church.

The Suggestion Box – 3 suggestions have been received which are as follows:

They feel the furniture in the lobby needs to be replaced. It was noted that the council will look to the Memorial Funds to make this purchase.

We should go back to Coffee and Donuts between services. This will be looked into.

Why is the Pastor's visitations not put in the newsletter? The council discussed that this would be a HIPAA violation to note names and this would not be allowed.

Time Change for monthly Council Meetings – it was noted that council will meet earlier and try it to see how it goes. Future Council Meetings will meet at 6 p.m. instead of 7 p.m.

Repair of Parsonage Doors (4) – Kitchen outside door does not close all the way. Kitchen cupboard needs fixing. Pocket door in the kitchen needs to be replaced, and the accordion door on the closet does not stay in the track. It was noted that these will be referred to Kevin and to check with Zack Osantowski for quote.

Installation Service – It was discussed that we would like Pastor Steve Lein to do a power point presentation after the 2<sup>nd</sup> service before the luncheon after Pastor Ed's installation service.

Erica Squanda came to the council meeting to mention that she is trying to start some youth activities in the Reese area. She noted that they were having a Tailgate Party Friday night for the last Reese Football game from 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. at the Dentist Office. All are welcome.

Rich Sylvester – Rich handed out an outline of the "Pastor Parish Support Group". This group was discussed during the call committee meetings, which would be formed to help

support the pastor. This would be on a confidential basis and the members would be chosen by the Pastor. This group is not designed to make decisions or to bring things to the council. There would be no term limits, those chosen could serve as long as they desired. The Group's Mission Statement is: "The Pastor Parish Support Group maintains an open relationship between the pastor, staff, council and members of the congregation". A motion was made by Dale to approve the concept of the Pastor Parish Support Group as it is acceptable, it was seconded by Linda.

Meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m. Next Meeting will be November 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.
